BALINESE [BAL] (Standard Source: FIFe 1987)

General

The ideal Balinese is a svelte, dainty cat with long tapering lines, very lithe and muscular; in excellent physical condition. The coat is medium long and silky, slightly longer around the neck and long on the tail to form a brush or plume. Body, points, and eye colour conform in all respects to the comparable Siamese varieties; the only difference is in hair length.

Tail Bone structure long, thin and tapering to a point. Hair long and spreading out to

form a plume.

Coat Medium long over the body, longer around the neck and on the tail to form a plume.

Fine and silky texture, without any undercoat.
